She has used singular helping verbs (there is (are)) and articles ( a new techniques (new techniques) while mentioning about plurals. Reply to the last question (If you could work in that country.....) was missing. Some sentences have not been answered in proper sequence.

Try making your accent, neutral.

Be careful of your grammatical mistakes.
