Comments: Candidate's response is not up to the mark. Replies to the cue card questions are unstructured and lack coherence. Pronunciation of many words contains native accent which is inappropriate. There are many mistakes of tenses. There are too many pauses and sound of "aaa..". Repetition of words like "the the" "to to" is also there.

Suggestions: Try using neutral accent to make your speech clear and audible.
Give detailed answers to the topic under discussion.
Practice using rich vocabulary words e.g. culture, profession, land of opportunities, fascination etc.
